CRITERIA

Applications for the Whangarei Agricultural & Pastoral Society Scholarship are invited from students who are domiciled within the boundaries of the Northland Regional Council area.

The scholarship is for those contemplating or who are already participating in agricultural related tertiary study, (eg. Diplomas, Degrees, NZQA Level 3 and above, or equivalent.)

HOW TO APPLY

Complete the application form and post, email or hand deliver it to the Whangarei Agricultural & Pastoral Society.

The application requires the following:

- A half page item introducing themselves, including education, interests, achievements etc.
- An electronic head and shoulders photograph of themselves suitable for publicity purposes.
- A 500 word essay explaining "Why I have chosen Agriculture as a career".
- Applications may be supported by CV's, written references or verified Academic Records.

CONDITIONS

A payment of **\$2,500.00 per annum** for a three year period (**\$7,500.00**) will be paid to the successful student to assist with their studies.

The initial payment of \$2,500.00 will be paid upon acceptance by the tertiary educational institution of their choice.

To receive subsequent payments the student must receive or be comparable to achieve a B grade average. Copies of examination results must be furnished to the Society on completion of each year's study.



Recipients will be required to prepare a report for the Whangarei Agricultural & Pastoral Society at completion of each academic year.

The Whangarei Agricultural & Pastoral Society reserves to itself the right to feature the successful applicant's report or profile in any promotional material or activities.

Should the successful applicant not complete their agricultural studies, then a pro rata sum of the grant already advanced shall be reimbursed to the Society.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

A selection committee will review all applications received. A range of criteria will be considered including the applicant's academic records, personal profile and evidence of their commitment to agriculture.

Short listed applicants will be asked to attend an interview in person, in November.
